Everybody who lives in Waldshut-Tiengen should be able to participate in community, cultural and social life here. That also applies to people on a low income. To help all citizens participate fully in what's on offer locally, whatever their financial situation, Waldshut-Tiengen issues its WT-Card. This gives people entitled to benefits access to a range of discounts. Obviously, the card can't solve underlying problems, but it is designed to lighten the load and make a statement. It signals that everybody, irrespective of their economic situation, is a valued and welcome part of our community.



WHO CAN GET THE WT-CARD?

People who receive unemployment benefit II or social security according to SGB II (Social Security Code)

People who receive living cost benefit or a basic old-age pension or a disability pension according to SGB XII

People who receive family allowance according to § 6a, Family Allowance Act

People who receive benefits according to the Asylum Seekers' Allowance Act

People who receive a grant according to the Vocational Education Grants Act

People who receive housing benefit according to the Housing Benefit Act, who live in Waldshut-Tiengen and submit a current confirmation of entitlement to one of the above benefits with their application for the card.

HOW CAN I GET MY WT-CARD?

Simply send your application for the WT-Card to the Department for Children and Youth of Waldshut-Tiengen. You can pick up forms from council offices, citizen's advice bureaus and other public offices. Alternatively you can download the form here:

HOW LONG IS THE WT-CARD VALID FOR?

The WT-Card is valid for the period of entitlement to the above benefits. It can be extended by the same amount of time when the benefit period is extended.

The card is only valid together with an official identity document.

WHAT DISCOUNTS ARE AVAILABLE?

Currently, you can get discounts on tickets for swimming baths, theatres, VHS (adult education centre) courses, and boat trips. You can also get a free day ticket for WTV public transport. WT-Card holders can use the municipal libraries for free. You can also find a current overview of all discounts here: www.waldshut-tiengen.de/Sozialpass. The list is growing all the time.
